Introduction to Other modules

Application Management Module

The applicant management module comprises of all facilities you will need to call for new applications, Conduct interviews, assign followers to communicate with the applicants and record applicant assessment and conduct applicant evaluations and the selection process. The applicant can also be converted to students easily.

Course Management Module

This module allows the user to manage and set up the university syllabus, courses, course schedules, and semester preparations and manage degree and subject grade boundaries and classifications. Lecturers can also be assigned to their relevant subject from this module

Exam Management Module

This allows the users to manage all activities with regard to exam management by the examinations department of the university. This module will allow users to approve and print exam admission forms, set exam timetables, record exam attendance, exam and course work mark. This module also generates result sheet reports for the board of examiners, result sheets for notice board etc. In terms of managing security the exam marks can be locked once the results are finalized. The individual student transcripts can be printed or emailed and sent to the students. The software provides the facility for the lecturers to enter the results of their relevant subjects and get finalized result sheets for the subjects as well.

Lecturer Management Module

This module manages as the transactions in relation to managing part time lectures. This will allow users to create lecturer appointments and automatically print appointment letters for each lecturer. This will also allow the users to record lecturer attendance, generate payment vouchers and make lecturer payments as well.

Human Resource Management Module

The HR management module consist of facility to manage company employees such as storing employee details, qualifications details, past work experience, salary details , attendance recording including finger print attendance capturing, appointment creation, Leave and over time maintenance and termination and resignation management.

Student Portal
